- \* Children and youth with complex needs requiring services and/or supports that exceed present service delivery system.

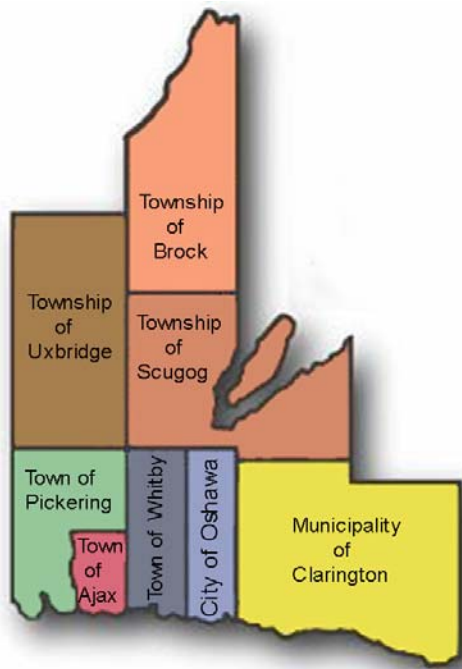
The children and youth we support meet the eligibility requirements for services offered by the Ministry of Children and Youth Services.

## Overview

Co-ordination Services for Children and Youth – Durham Region is funded by the Ministry of Children and Youth Services to assist service providers and children/youth with complex needs and their families to navigate, access, and utilize the local and regional services to create long term plans for each individual child/youth.

## Funding Options

We assist with accessing specialized funding options to meet the identified needs of the child/youth as well as assist families and service providers with an examination of current funding utilization to ensure optimal benefit to the child/youth.

Short term “*Hard To Serve Funds*” may be available from Co-ordination Services to support a child/youth’s immediate critical need.



## Service Plan Development

A Service Co-ordinator will assist the family and service providers/case managers in developing an Integrated Service Plan. Plans identify long and short term goals of the family, child/youth, and service providers. Case conferencing may be used to bring parties together to work collaboratively and creatively with the child/youth, family, and service providers to build a plan that enhances strengths and addresses needs.

The Service Co-ordinator will oversee and offer assistance to service providers and families in the implementation and/or changing of a Service Plan.

By working collaboratively with other agencies, Co-ordination Services is able to aid in the development of group solutions and an enhanced service delivery for clients at all levels.

## Regional Services

A Service Co-ordinator may assist you with exploring and accessing Regional Programs that support complex children/youth from Durham Region. These may include, but are not limited to, the Residential Dual Diagnosis Assessment Program in Durham, Regional Respite Program in 4 Counties, Autism Respite in York Region, and the Complex Special Needs Program in Barrie. Staff are also knowledgeable about other specialized services throughout the Province of Ontario and can assist families in exploring those that may meet their needs.
