

Assistance for Children with Severe Disabilities (ACSD)

ACSD is a monthly government funding program for eligible children up to the age of 18 years with severe disability who are residents of Ontario living at home.

ACSD eligibility may be approved if your total household income is \$76,200 or less. This funding supports families with expenses related to the child/youth's needs and daily care. This can include funding for things such as specialized clothing or equipment, assistive devices, transportation costs, respite support, and other related needs.
