

Special Services at Home (SSAH)

SSAH is an annual government funding program for eligible children up to the age of 18 with developmental or physical disability who are residents of Ontario.

SSAH helps offset costs related to personal development and growth which focuses on helping a child or youth learn new skills, and become more independent in daily life, relationships, and the community, and/or provides family relief and support. This can include funding things such as respite worker costs, camp and recreation programming registration, 1:1 worker support costs, home attendant services such as house cleaning, yard maintenance or snow removal and more.
